Disaster can strike anytime, anywhere. It takes many forms—a hurricane, an earthquake, a tornado, a flood, a fire or a hazardous spill, or an act of terrorism. Effective initial response by a facility Emergency Response Team can mitigate or minimize consequences of an incident.

Participants will learn valuable skills by participating in an enhanced Tabletop Exercise. The exercise will also enable the facility operator to satisfy regulatory requirements for drills and exercises, including Title 33 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 154.1055 (a), and 33 CFR 105.220(c).
